If you are responsible for entries for your club please see a message from carnival recorder Liz Eustace at the end of this bulletin.

All clubs are required to enter their competitors online using the Sports Event Management System (SEMS) Normal entries close 5pm on Wednesday 16/01/2019 and late entries must be give to carnival recorded, Liz Eustace by <u>8am on the day of the carnival</u>, <u>Sunday 20th Janurary 2019</u>. Please note, Clubs when doing Carnival entries, will be required to enter competitors in individual events. If you have any questions regarding this, please direct them to Toby Whitton (VSO) or ask Liz Eustace (Carnival Recorder) to talk you through how to do this at the Carnival. Also, please ensure that all awards paperwork for Junior Awards (Preliminary and Competition Skills Evaluations) have been submitted before trying to enter your members, as SEMS will not allow members to enter who are still showing on Surfguard as not proficient or currently holding the award.

Officials: Those clubs that have competitors participating in this year's events MUST supply a minimum of

ONE Level 1 Surf Sports Official and then additional Officials (Junior Official accredited and above) for every TEN (or part there) Competitors. The 1:10 ratio ensures adequate Officials are available

to allow the event program to run to time and for multiple areas to be set up.

High Visibility Vests: All competitors MUST wear high visibility vests when competing. Please refer to the Page 18 of the

Supplementary regulations:

Approved sanctioned events outside of the regulations of the Surf Sports Manual 35th Edition to be run at this event, include:

- Under 8 Foamie will be run if conditions permit a final decision will be made by the carnival referee prior to the event. Note this event will not be run at the state titles.
- U8 age groups will not compete in a full Cameron (to include board leg). The Cameron for U8 age group will consist of 2 waders and 2 sprinters.
- 1km beach run may be conducted if sufficient interest and beach available to conduct event. Sandshoes permitted.
- Board and Cameron relays will be alternated each carnival.
- In team events Male & Female events will be run if possible, Mixed Teams will contest in the Male event, and if insufficient numbers in an event an Open event may be run.
- All events will be held in accordance with the rules set out in the SLSA 35th Edition Surf Sports Manual, any subsequent SLSA Bulletins and SLST Local Rules that are distributed to Surf Sports Managers via Circulars from time to time.

A message from Liz Eustace, our carnival recorder, to those responsible for club entries:

Attention to those that do club entries for carnival;

We have now had our 2nd lot of carnivals using the new SEMS system - all seems to going well, but like all new systems there is always going to be glitches, teething problems and trial & error while it is being trialed. SLSA staff are working on these teething problems and glitches and ways to improve the system for all doing entries and results. We have had lots of positive feedback from the beach over the first 2 carnivals - ie the event sheets with names listed which assists with the marshalling for events, as well as making it easier for the recorders on the line.

What we would like to ask of the clubs is that when doing entries that they make sure:

- all athletes are entered prior to the closing date of the carnival looking at having closing on the Wednesday prior to the carnival so that the print off of the sheets can start on the Thursday so all is ready for action on the morning of the carnival.
- all athletes have been checked that they are registered and have the required awards prior to closing date of the carnival entries and or results can't be processed if the athlete isn't a current member or proficient for 2018/19 season. We will only accept late athlete entries on the day if there is paper evidence that the athlete is financial and proficient. Late athlete entries on the day will be charged a late entry fee.
- Team are entered into Team contests including the team members for the team (50% of team member names can be changed on the day but if they are named in the contest already this will make it easier when entering results)

I would like to meet with all officials especially the marshals and recorders in briefing at the start of each carnival so that we can explain what is required of them (in reality having the printed off sheets for each contest will make the recorders job a lot easier - as the names will be there and it's just a matter of marking the place down).

Thanks for the understanding for all the clubs and taking on board the suggestions and feedback from us to you also. We are all volunteers doing entries and results - so need to work together to make it work for us all.
